Sir,

With reference to your letter No 2411 dated 5<sup>th</sup> Instant and accompaniment I have the honor to state that owing to the supply of filtered water being insufficient to flush the privy referred to the dra connecting it with the main sewer will frequently be choked and causes the nuisance complained of.

The filtered water laid on is wholly insufficient to supply the many taps in the premises and also to flush the privy. I would suggest therefore that you call

for an estimate to lay on unfiltered  
water to the Latrine - from the unfiltered  
water main in College Street for the  
supply of water to the Latrine alone -  
as this would have the filtered water  
to be used for its more legitimate purposes. -

The cost of doing this would be  
about Rs 500/-
