Please refer to General Department telegram from Ramna received on the 24th August 1913 permitting certain officers of the Education Department to serve on the Patna University sub-committee. In terms of the above order Mr. S. C. Mahalanavis a Professor, Presidency College was placed on deputation for the purpose from 4th September to 18th September 1913.

2. Reference is solicited in this connexion to para 2 of Govt. order No. 3537, dated the 24th July 1913 from which it will be seen that it was ordered in the case of Shams-ul-Ulama Abu Naser Waheed, Supdt., Dacca Madrasa that the Govt. of Bihar and Orissa would bear the cost of his pay, deputation allowance and travelling allowance. It is presumed that the same procedure will be followed in the case of Mr. Mahalanavis. I accordingly ask that the necessary action may be taken in this regard. I also recommend that the Govt. of Bihar and Orissa may be asked to grant to Mr. Mahalanavis deputation allowance for the above period at the rate of one-fifth of salary. Such allowance, it is understood, has already been granted to Mr. Archbold.
